

These can include admin, HR, payroll, inventory records, engineering, legal contracts, accounting etc. The data can be encrypted, regardless of the location. And, IT can manage Enigma. Data is secure from all except those who have knowledge of the correct password. And, yes, passwords can be easily changed. Enigma is scalable, and can be used-and managed-by a consumer or a large entity. In companies, everyone who accesses encrypted data will have his or her own Enigma.


